Please review the acceptable documentation below and submit 1 photocopy, front and back, of the indicated documentation. Documentation of non---US citizens must not have an expiration date prior to the start of the academic year and will be submitted by PCC to the Department of Homeland Security for confirmation.

Eligible Categories	Required Documentation
US Citizen or National	US Birth Certificate, US Passport/Passport Card current or expired, Certificate of Naturalization (form N-550 or N-570), Certificate of Citizenship (form N-560 or N-561), or Documentation of Citizen Abroad (form FS-240, FS-545, or DS-1350.
US Permanent Resident	Permanent Resident Card (form I-551, Resident Alien Card (form I-551), Departure Record (form I-94), Arrival Departure Record (form I-94) with the endorsement 'Processed for I-551'. 'Temporary I-551' or 'Processed for I-551'. Temporary Evidence for Lawful Residence, or Visa in an unexpired foreign passport with a US Customs and Border Protection inspector admission stamp and the statement 'Upon Endorsement Serves as Temporary If I-551 Evidencing Permanent Residence for 1 Year', or US Travel Document (form I-327 with stamp 'Permit to Reenter').
Refugee	Departure Record (form I-94A) or Arrival Departure Record (form I-94) with stamp showing admission as refugee under Section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality act or '209b Pending. Employment Authorized', or US Travel Document (form I-571) with stamp 'Permit to Reenter'.
Asylee	Departure Record (form I-94A) or Arrival Departure Record (form I-94) with stamp showing admission asylee under Section 208 of the Immigration and Nationality Act or '209b pending. Employment Authorized or US Travel Document (form I-571) with stamp 'Permit to Reenter'.
Parolee	Departure Record (form If 94A) or Arrival Departure Record (form I-94) with stamp indicating 'Alien paroled into the US pursuant to Section 212 (d)(5)'.
Victim of Human Trafficking or Spouse, Child or Parent of Victim	Victim must submit certification letter from the Department of Health and Human Services. Spouse, child or parent of victim must submit a copy of the victim's certification letter and a copy of their T-Visa.

## Ineligible Categories

- Applicant for Permanent Resident Status and not in a category listed above
- A Student with a non-immigration Visa
- A Student with only an Employment Authorization
