(B) **Earnings and Compensation:** This sections contains code for employee type (certificated, non certificated) and pay basis (monthly, hourly, etc.) This field also displays up to 44 lines of individual earnings detail with the last line used to summarize any overflow data. The field also contains the rate of pay and the extended amount.
