secondyr accredited and degree program and, Enroll in at least half-time study as defined by the student's institution and, Planning to complete the degree program w/two years. **Criteria** used for selection of candidates: Completed application form w/supporting materials and reference letter, with all material receive by posted deadline.

Application: Applications must be postmarked by July 1, 2008. Your application pack must include the following: A completed application form, Two letters of recommendation on letterhead dated and signed within one year prior to the final filing date, which must be attached to the completed. Verification of acceptance into second year and degree program. A one page typed essay describing personal and professional goals. Copy of 2007 tax return OR verification of income OR copy of parent/guardian 2007 tax return (if applicant is claimed as dependent). Copy of transcript from first completed year of nursing program. NOTE: Faxes will not be accepted. Applications are available at www.calnurses.org and Financial Aid, L114. The deadline is July 1, 2008.
