Welcome and Introductions

Co-Chair Update

President Vurdien announced that the Aspen Institute has named Pasadena City College one of the top ten community colleges in the nation. PCC is a finalist for the Aspen Prize for Community College Excellence — one of only 10 schools nationwide to receive this honor. The ASPEN prize will be announced in March 2017. President Vurdien shared that the Community College League ranked PCC #1 in California in the following areas: number of degrees awarded, number of degrees awarded to minority students, and number #1 in the number of degrees awarded to Asian American students. Additionally, President Vurdien shared that PCC has some budget restraints that effects building construction and improvements. President Vurdien stated that ACCJC is sending a team on Oct. 19 to review the actions PCC has taken to address the nine recommendations. President Vurdien reviewed the success rate of students at PCC based on their ethnicity (handout). Co-Chair Martínez requested that the committee review the data provided and discuss in more detail during the next PLAC meeting.
