During this time of uncertainty, the California Community College Chancellor’s Office has allowed community colleges to extend options for grading from Spring 2020 through the end of Fall 2021. PCC is supporting students through this difficult time by providing 2 options for alternative grading;

1. Pass/No Pass
2. Excused Withdrawal

Whenever possible, we encourage our students to end their courses with traditional grading. If this is not possible, students should make informed decisions about selecting either of the alternative grading options. Future transfer plans and Financial Aid can be affected by your decision to change grade options and the timing of the decision. Carefully consider the implications of your options before submitting this form as the decision cannot be reversed.

PASS / NO PASS GRADING POLICY AND AGREEMENT 2020-2021

The **P** grading symbol, indicates a student has earned credit for the course. This is the equivalent of a grade of C or better, but the units earned are not counted in the student’s GPA. **NP** indicates no credit has been earned. This is the equivalent of a grade of D or F. This is a less than satisfactory or failing grade but does not count against a student’s GPA.

- I understand I am requesting grading for courses as Pass/No Pass (P/NP) instead of a letter grade.
- I understand my decision cannot be changed after the P/NP option has been selected.
- I understand a course I have earned a Pass in cannot be repeated for credit at PCC.
- I understand other colleges and universities may restrict acceptance of courses taken on a Pass/No Pass basis, especially to satisfy a major requirements and for admission to programs with “impacted” status.
- I understand the usual rules of the Pass/No Pass policy have been suspended for Spring 2020 through Fall 2021. (ex: last day to request P/NP has been extended; one course per term limit has been waived; limit of 12 total units of P/NP at PCC has been waived).
- I understand discussing this with a counselor is a good way to determine the best grade option for me and I can access a Counselor through the Virtual Support Center located on the PCC Homepage.

EXCUSED WITHDRAWAL 2020-2021

An Excused Withdrawal (EW) allows students who had extenuating circumstances* to have D, F (substandard grades), or W removed from counting against them as an attempt for a course enrollment. The EW replaces the D, F, or W grade on the student record at the end of the semester. The grade requires the student to provide verifiable documentation regarding the circumstance.
