## 5. Elective Course Requirements

 $\Box$  10 elective units, chosen from the following two areas of elective courses (any combination of General Education or Paralegal Studies Elective courses are permitted):

- a. If student is pursuing an Associate of Science Degree, it is recommended to choose the 10 elective units from their selected GE pattern: CSU GE, IGETC, or PCC Local GE.
- b. If student is pursing the Certificate ONLY, it is recommended to choose the 10 elective units from the list of Paralegal Studies Elective courses below:
