y dog and I have been together for 3 years. She is very good and clever. She has dark brown hair and round eyes. When she came to my home, we liked her.




ost people of the world know and love Pandas, because they look so cute. My parents took me to the zoo of my hometown almost every week when I was a child. My father told me a lot about pandas.

## Don't Let Technology Devices Occupy Tradition


