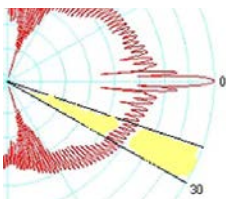


Paid Science Research Opportunities Available for Community College Students Now Recruiting!
