<b>Nune Garipian:</b>	<p>She attended the legislative breakfast this morning where they announced that PCC PROMISE, a program that will provide two semesters worth of tuition for qualifying in-district high school graduates.</p> <p>There will be a Board of Trustees meeting next Wednesday and would really like to see the executive board attend.</p> <p>Reported that the Board of Trustees passed a resolution in support of undocumented students and students in distress, in response to the resolution passed by A.S and Academic Senate. The president of UJIMA as well as some of their members were there and the president spoke about how he was in support of the resolution.</p> <p>Her committee is working with Carrie to organize a SafeZones training that is open to all clubs, A.S. members and Office of Student Life staff. They are also planning to create an anonymous survey for undocumented students.</p>
<b>Dean Wyrzykowski:</b>	The Student Lobby Committee has recommended a legislative agenda for the federal level that he will present to the board under 'Bill Acceptance'. The committee is currently preparing for their trip to Washington D.C. and one of the ways they are preparing is by visiting local legislative offices of congress members.


