C. REVIEW PROVISIONAL BUDGET

Mr. Winter thanked everyone for taking the time on their Saturday to attend this meeting to discuss the one agenda item. After through discussion, the committee recommended to bring the provisional budget to the Executive Committee.

D. RECOMMENDATION FOR NAMING OPPORTUNITY FOR LUCILLE JONES

Ms. Abram informed the committee that Lucille Jones left \$750,000 to Pasadena City College. The money is indeed an unrestricted gift. It is this committee that will make a recommendation to the Executive Committee on how the funds should be used. For now, they are accounted for in a separately named account.

Ms. Abram and the committee deliberated on some ways to honor Lucille Jones.

MOTION: ON MOTION OF Ms. Burt and Mr. Hawkins, the Finance and Investment Committee voted by a unanimous vote (Sarni, Hawkins, Schield, Ladesich, Burt, Kanter and Winter) of the seven members present for recommendation that Ms. Abram come back with more recommendations to honor Lucille Jones that also include cost estimates.

E. REPORTS

1. Clifford Swan Report

Following the British exit from the European union, global markets responded negatively. U.S. markets were not immune. The S&P 500 lost 5.3% over two trading days before reversing course. The second quarter of 2016 ended in positive territory, however, the S&P 500 returned 2.4% in Q2 2016.

Clifford Swan cannot predict the ultimate impact on global economic or political policy or the interim disruptions that might occur along the way. They also cannot predict what lies ahead as we approach election season in the U.S.

"Brexit" does not alter our fundamental approach. Events in Europe have caused a further strengthening of the US dollar. Interest rates also continue to be low, and that is likely to remain for some time. The 10-Year U.S. Treasury has reached an all-time low. Therefore Clifford Swan is avoiding undue risk in fixed income, tending to favor securities that are short in duration, high quality, and liquid.

2. Financials

The committee reviewed the attached financials and this being the beginning of the new fiscal year there were few questions. The financials were accepted as presented. The discussion led to a more in depth discussion about the budget.

3. First Review of Budget Draft 2016-2017

The committee discussed the first draft of the budget and Ms. Abram advised them that the proposed budget is dependent on the approval by the Board of Trustees to allow the Southern California Public Radio (SCPR) donation to become unrestricted. If this request is not approved, then the budget needs to be readjusted.

Ms. Abram said as the Foundation office is going into the campaign, there will be increased expenses. Three of the four initiatives of the campaign are to raise money for college items. She advised that if we don't have unrestricted money to move forward, then we will be moving very slowly, raising funds for one initiative at a time.

We will be asking the college to allow the SCPR funds as unrestricted. The total amount is \$300,000, \$75,000 each quarter.

Mr. Sarni and Mr. Schield pointed out that the committee that we are not projecting a deficit budget but it does depend on raising \$175,000 in unrestricted funds this year.

F. Sub-Committee for Negotiating Contract with the College

A sub-committee to include Jim Sarni, Jon Fuhrman and Lonnie Schield will meet with Bobbi to discuss re-negotiating the contract with the College.

G. Renegotiation of Contract with SCPR Restriction

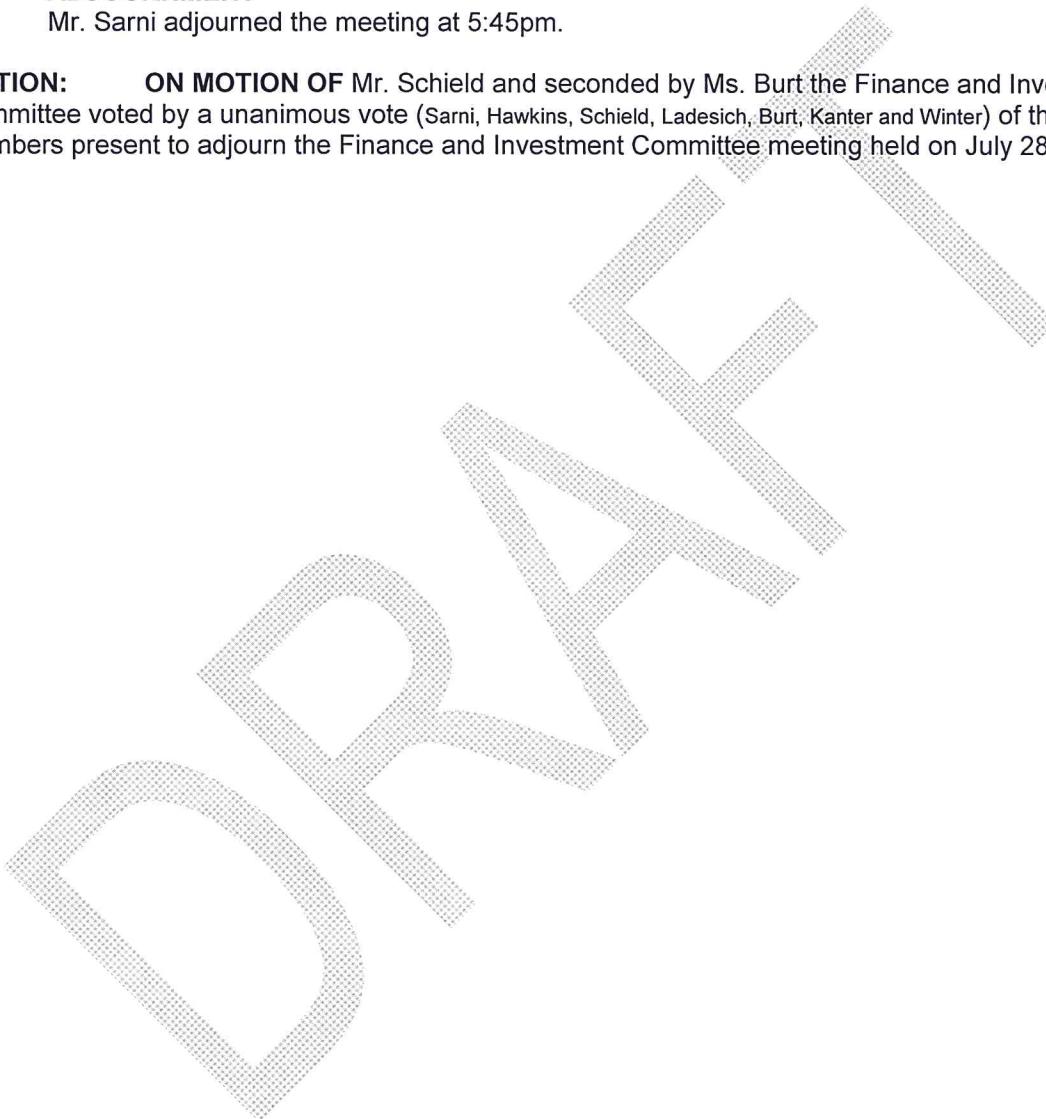

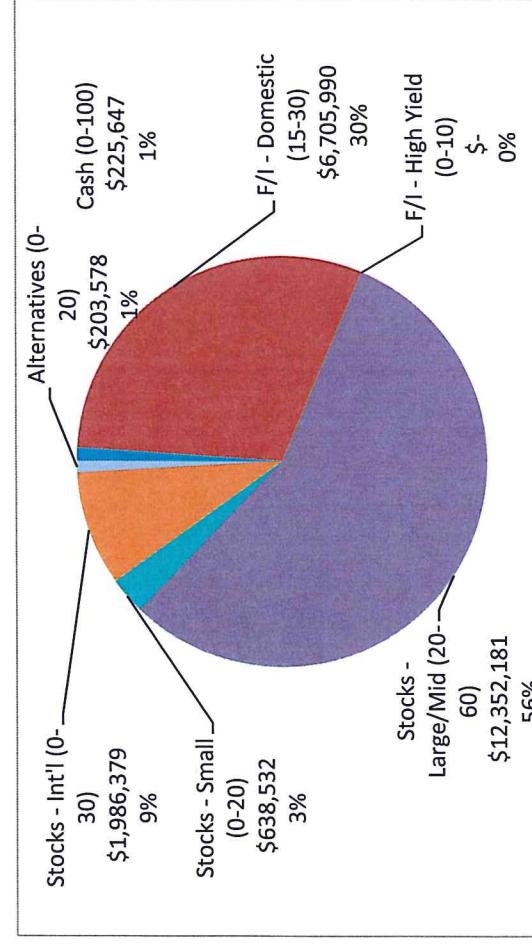
