ART 004D HISTORY OF MODERN ART

3 units

A survey of the history of modern art that provides an overview of art and architecture from the Western modern period of the 19th and 20th centuries. Total of 54 hours lecture.

Transfer Credit: CSU; UC. *C-ID: ARTH 150

Grade Mode: L, A, P

Rationale: The History of Modern Art needs to be updated to reflect the state-wide C-ID Descriptor for ARTH 150. The current course content list is unnecessarily extensive/detailed compared to the C-ID Descriptor for ARTH150. The important factor is to cover content from the beginning of the 19th century through the entire 20th century as per the C-ID General Course Description. Modification to SPOs, removed Recommended Preparation, MOEs, CCOs, catalog description.
