#### **BUSINESS INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY – ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT – Associate in Science, Certificate of Achievement**

The curriculum prepares students for business positions such as administrative assistant, secretary, executive assistant, and office assistant. Employees in these types of positions perform a variety of administrative tasks including document processing, using computer applications such as presentation graphics and spreadsheets, scheduling appointments, researching and organizing information, and arranging meetings and travel.

Upon successful completion of this certificate, students will be prepared to take the Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) certification exams in Word, Outlook, and Excel.

A Certificate of Achievement is awarded upon completion of all required courses with a grade of C or better.

**Grade Mode:** L, A

**Rationale:** HOSP 002 is not part of the TMC model for Hospitality Management and therefore, is not one of the listed Hospitality classes for the AD-T. So, it becomes obsolete as a pertinent class for transfer.

#### **ENGLISH**

#### **ADDITION – Effective Summer 2021**

##### **ENGL 150 SUPPORT FOR ENGLISH 001A**

###### **½ unit**

**Corequisite:** ENGL 001A.

Review of core prerequisite skills competencies, and concepts for college-level composition, with an emphasis on critical thinking skills and reflective and recursive awareness. Topics include learning strategies and reading and writing knowledge delivered through a learning community experience that offers additional support and practice for college-level composition through collaborative, hands-on workshops and activities. Intended for students who are concurrently enrolled in ENGL 001A. Total of 36 hours laboratory.

**Grade Mode:** P

**Rationale:** This course is being proposed as an optional co-requisite course for ENGL 001A in accordance with multiple measures placement as outlined in AB705 intended for students desiring additional support to successfully complete ENGL 001A. This lab support course will provide reading and writing workshop support as well as study skills and just-in-time review of prerequisite knowledge for ENGL 001A.

#### **MODIFICATION – SLOs, SPOs, CCOs, prerequisite (removal of MATH 007B) – Effective Summer 2021**

## **MATH 005A SINGLE VARIABLE CALCULUS I**

**5 units**

**Prerequisite:** MATH 008 or MATH 009, or placement based on the Math assessment process. Limits, differentiation, and integration of functions of a single variable including the Mean Value Theorem and the Fundamental Theorem of Calculus. No credit if taken after MATH 005AH.

Total of 90 hours lecture.

Transfer Credit: CSU; UC credit limitations. See counselor. C-ID: MATH 211; MATH SEQ 900S (WITH MATH 005B)

**Grade Mode:** L, P

**Rationale:** C-ID did not approve the previous version of Math 005AH; so to keep Math 005A parallel with Math 005AH, this course is also being resubmitted with changes to the SLOs, SPOs and the CCOs to bring the course into alignment with current C-ID guidelines. Math 7B was also removed as a prerequisite as the 7A-7B Precalculus series has been replaced with the Math 3-8 series. Please submit for C-ID Review for Math 211.

## **MODIFICATION – SLOs, SPOs, CCOs, prerequisite (removal of MATH 007B) – Effective Summer 2021**

### **MATH 005AH HONORS SINGLE VARIABLE CALCULUS I**

**5 units**

**Prerequisite:** MATH 008 or MATH 009, or placement based on the Math assessment process

Enrollment Limitations: Acceptance into the Honors Program.

Limits, differentiation, and integration of functions of a single variable including the Mean Value Theorem and the Fundamental Theorem of Calculus. As an honors course, students will be expected to complete additional assignments involving more extensive proofs and problem solving to gain deeper insight into single variable calculus theory and applications. No credit if taken after MATH 005A. Total of 90 hours lecture.

Transfer Credit: CSU; UC

**Grade Mode:** L, P

**Rationale:** C-ID did not approve the previous version of Math 005AH, so this course is being resubmitted with changes to the SPOs and the CCOs to bring the course into alignment with current C-ID guidelines. Math 7B was also removed as a prerequisite as the 7A-7B Precalculus series has been replaced with the Math 3-8 series. Please resubmit for C-ID Math 211.

## **MODIFICATION – SLOs, SPOs, CCOs, MOIs, MOEs, catalog description, contact hours (90 to 72), prerequisite (removed MATH 003, MATH 007A, added MATH 005A), texts – Effective Summer 2021**

### **MATH 022 DISCRETE MATHEMATICS**

**4 units**

**Prerequisite:** MATH 005A or CS 002 or placement based on the Math assessment process.

Study of finite mathematical systems. Includes set theory, logic, modular arithmetic, combinatorics, relations and functions, matrix algebra, Boolean algebra, recursion, graph theory. For mathematics and computer science majors, but open to all qualified students. Total of 72 hours lecture.

Transfer Credit: CSU, UC

**Grade Mode:** L, A, P

**Rationale:** Rewrite SLOs, SPOs, and CCOs to be more concise and to align with the C-ID. Align numbering of SPOs with SLOs. Request C-ID Math 160, Discrete Mathematics. Change contact hours to comply with unit-hour correspondence and to allow for inclusion in the AD-T and to alleviate student financial burden. Change prerequisite to Calculus I to be in line with CSUs and UCs as well as because instructors have observed that success is significantly lower for students who enroll with the current minimum prerequisite (Math 3, 7A, 7B, 8). Include MOI, MOE, and update textbooks. Modification to catalog description.

## **NATURAL SCIENCE**

**MODIFICATION – course title, SPOs, CCOs, MOIs, MOEs, catalog description, NCN (30 to 27), assignments, texts – Effective Summer 2021**

### **BIOL 005B TOPICS IN APPLIED BOTANY: PLANT BIOLOGY IN DEMONSTRATION GARDENS**

#### **1 unit**

Field investigations in applied botany through the use of demonstration gardens and curricular development. Total of 9 hours lecture and 27 hours laboratory.

Transfer Credit: CSU

**Grade Mode:** L, A, P

**Rationale:** Modifications to CCOs, MOEs, MOIs, SPOs, assignments, texts, course title, catalog description. NCN: 27 - This course is taught primarily outdoors in demonstration garden areas at Botanical Gardens, School Gardens, Community Gardens and Diverse Student Driven Locals. All of these locations have narrow access for students to observe horticultural techniques being taught and practiced. While NCN:27 is not much smaller than an NCN:30, (ideally this course would be taught in a much smaller size), this reduction will support more equitable access for student learning and instructor delivery of important curriculum.

**MODIFICATION – SLOs, SPOs, MOEs, MOIs, catalog description, assignments, texts, NCN (30 to 32) – Effective Summer 2021**

### **SPCH 013 INTRODUCTION TO SPEECH COMMUNICATION**

#### **3 units**

Survey of the discipline of communication studies with emphasis on multiple epistemological, theoretical, and methodological issues relevant to the systematic inquiry and pursuit of knowledge about human communication. This course explores the basic history, assumptions, principles, processes, variables, methods, and specializations of human communication as an academic field of study. Recommended proficiency in spoken English. Total of 54 hours lecture.

Transfer Credit: CSU; UC. \*C-ID: COMM 180

**Grade Mode:** L

**Rationale:** This course has not been revised for a few years. Revisions made: SLOs, SPOs, assignments Methods of Instruction, Methods of Evaluation, textbooks, catalog description, increase NCN from 30 to 32.
