Curriculum audit:

Stephanie Fleming has been working on a document that describes a FIG initiative that faculty will apply for. Faculty will form groups of 6-8 with an identified facilitator. The facilitator and any adjunct faculty who participate will be stipended – funds to come from Guided Pathways (for the rest of the participants, it's part of their 5.5 service hours per week). They'll be trained and then review their curriculum, syllabi, pedagogy, etc. This will be presented to the Faculty Committee on Online Education next week, presented to the Senate as an info item on 11/9, and the Safe Learning Environment Committee will also be invited to give input.

C&I COR updates

There was a change to an AP last year such that courses that have not been updated recently (2 years for CTE, 6 years for non-CTE) will be scheduled to be archived. This is an attempt to get courses up to date.
