The Accreditation Standing Committee (ASC) met 17 times during the 2019-2020 academic year. The committee began the year by jointly reviewing the accreditation standards, eligibility requirements, commission policies, and the necessary evidence to support the Institutional Self - Evaluation Report (ISER). Committee members were assigned to chair standard writing committees to develop the narrative and identify needed evidence. Additionally, the committee reviewed and revised the institutional set-standards for the college and aligned them with the local Vision for Success goals where ever possible. Finally, over the courses of the spring semester the committee gathered evidence, developed, reviewed, and edited the entire ISER document.
