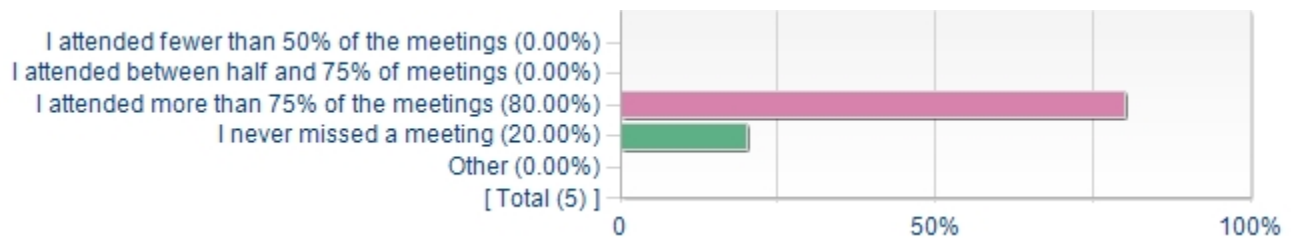

## How often did you attend committee meetings this academic year?

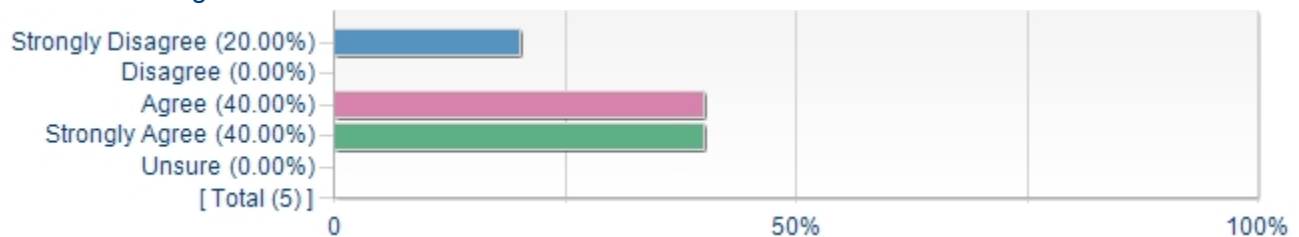

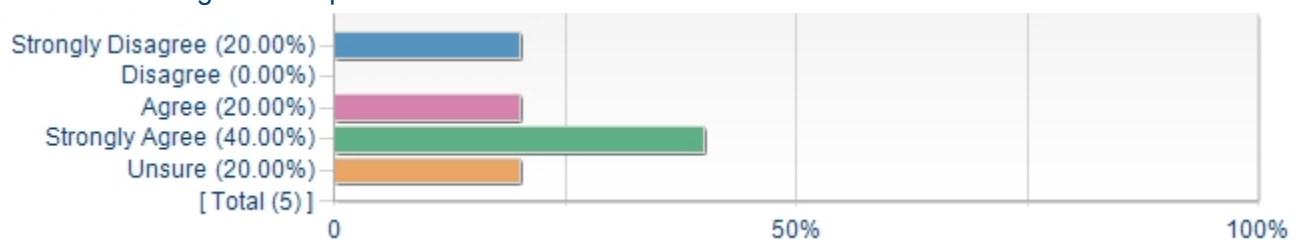

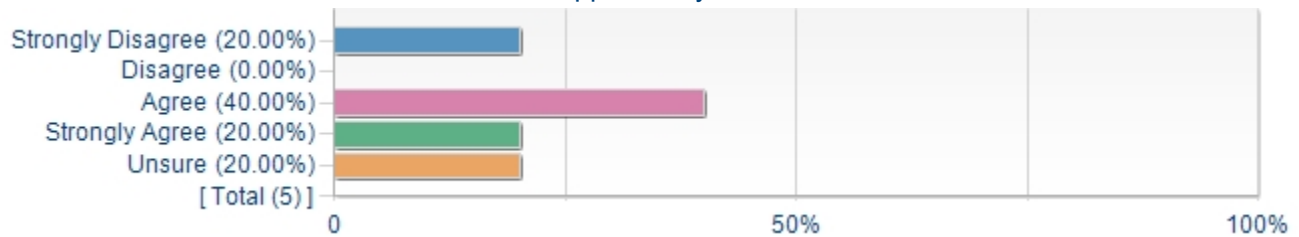

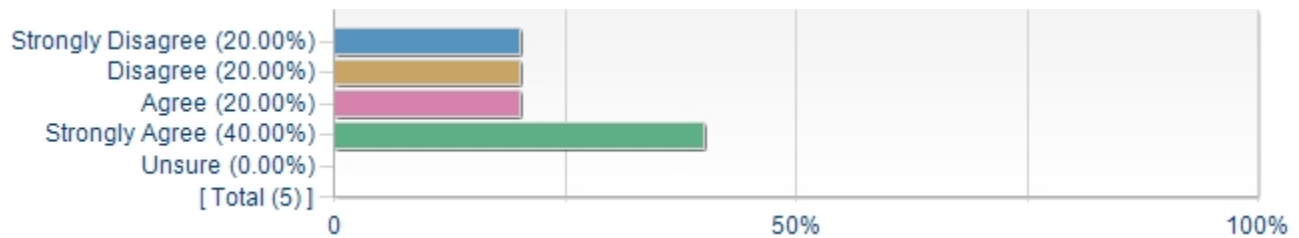

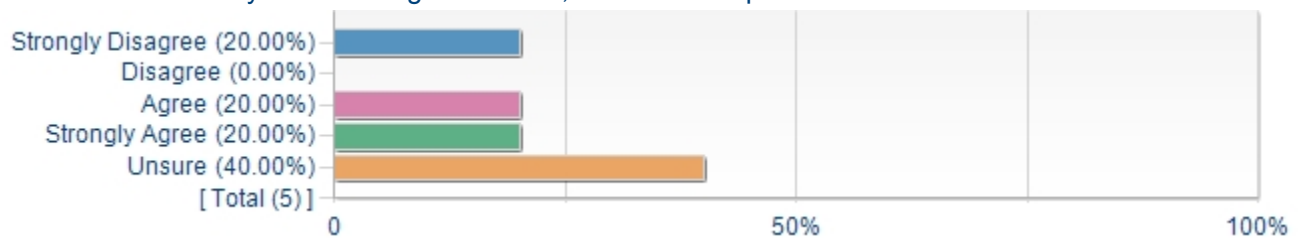
