1 PROPOSAL FROM THE 2 PASADENA AREA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO THE 3 PASADENA CITY COLLEGE FACULTY ASSOCIATION 4 June 16, 2022 5 6 The collective bargaining proposal presented herein by the Pasadena Area Community College 7 District to the Pasadena City College Faculty Association and is expressly made pursuant to the Education Employment Relations Act and the Collective Bargaining Contract between the parties. 8 9 The following article shall be deemed to remain unchanged in the Collective Bargaining 10 Agreement except as set forth below: 11 12 ARTICLE 174 (NEW) 13 REASSIGNED TIME 14 15 174.1 Full-time faculty may be presented the opportunity to perform certain tasks while on reassigned time from contractual duties. A reassigned time position will be 16 compensated pro-rata to the percentage of the employee's weekly assignment on 17 18 campus. 19 20 14.1.1 Reassigned time may be used in the Fall and Spring semesters. The 21 assignment must be approved by the primary supervising manager. All reassigned time positions shall be voluntary and shall not interfere with the 22 23 employee's non-released time contractual responsibilities. 24 25 14.1.2 Reassigned time assignments may be approved for up to two years. 26 Nothing precludes a full-time faculty member from re-applying after 27 serving in a reassigned time assignment. Exceptions may be made for 28 grant-funded projects or other long-term assignments with a specific 29 need for continuity. 30 31 174.2 The appropriate manager will develop a list of performance expectations that are 32 relevant to the assignment. These expectations will include, but are not limited to, the purpose of the assignment, objectives, expected outcomes and deliverables, 33 34 planned timelines, the percentage of the contractual load for the assignment, and the 35 scheduled hours for each week dedicated to the projects. These expectations will 36 provide the basis for the faculty member's performance evaluation. The evaluation of 37 released time is independent of the evaluations specified in the contract and relates only to the position specified. 38 39 40 174.3 All eligible employees and the Faculty Association shall be notified ten (10) business days during Fall and Spring semesters in advance of all reassigned time positions 41 via a job description that will include a description of the position, duties, knowledge 42 43 and experience required, the amount of reassigned time and the duration of the 44 position. 45 174.4 For positions other than those elected by faculty, a selection committee will be 46 constituted to screen, select candidates to interview, and make a recommendation 47

on the successful candidate to the Vice President of Instruction or Vice President of

administrators (the supervising manager and another administrator chosen by the appropriate Vice President) and three faculty members two of whom will be selected

Student Services. The selection committee will consist of five members: two
