2. Nomination and Election of New Vice Chair

3. Approval of Minutes – *Meeting October 26, 2016 #59* M/S/ P Motion to Approve Minutes. R. Olivarez /Trustee Wah. Approved as submitted.

The purpose of said Bond Election shall be for the voters of the District to vote on the following proposition (the "Bond Measure") which is to appear on the card notice of election and upon the ballot as follows:

"Shall the Pasadena Area Community College District repair and rehabilitate its facilities to meet current health, safety, accessibility and instructional standards, replace worn-out plumbing, upgrade existing electrical systems to better access technology, replace aging heating, ventilating and air conditioning systems, renovate outdated classrooms and other vocational training facilities, and construct other facilities to relieve overcrowding, by issuing \$150 million in bonds, at interest rates within the legal limit, and appoint a citizens oversight committee to oversee expenditures."

4. Projects Update (R. Smith)

Visual Arts and Media Studies Projects – R. Smith updated the committee members as to the current status of the Visual Arts and Media Studies Projects. The secondary effects projects are in various phases of design and construction. The Measure P project center encountered unforeseen challenges with the existing underground infrastructure, which has resulted in delays in the timeline for sculpture and ceramics patio project. An engineer has been hired to provide solutions to the mechanical and structural concerns.

Facilities is advancing to ensure all approvals are in place while ensuring fiscal accountability and compliance.

5. Measure P - Finance Report (*Pulcifer*)

S. Pulcifer provided a campus-wide reconstruction upgrade Budget Summary Report. Measure P is on (Fiscal) target and Facilities continues to closely monitor compliance and fiscal accountability.

Question: Status of the Center for the Arts past legal actions?

R. Smith responded: The past legal action in regards to the Center of the Arts building issues and the original builder no longer being in business has been resolved. Liberty Mutual who is the surety made an agreement with Kemp Bros to complete the Center of the Arts project. The project has been completed to all involved parties' satisfaction. All legal actions concerning the Center of the Arts have been resolved at this time.
